

What About BOB?



MAY 2023 \$23,458.65 **General Fund**



Grace Church Council met Monday, May 22, at 6:00pm, and reports of the various committees were discussed.

Staff/Parish, Updating job descriptions for the various staff members. Evaluations will begin shortly.

Missions, future plans for Operation Christmas Child are being decided. Missions Month is August. The Community -Wide Food Pantry Collection will be promoted. On August 26 & 27 from 10 am – 1 pm, the Food Pantry will collect items in our parking lot.

Finance Chair, Todd Davison, reported on the asset balances: Checking account balance \$333,633; Mission Fund \$23,666; Reserve Fund \$262,608; General Fund \$47, 358; Capital Expense Fund \$304,286; Capital Fund \$236,724; Mission Fund \$79,719. Total Assets \$668,088. Total Liabilities \$1,771.

As of 3/31/2023 YTD activity reflected actual receipts of \$75,537 as opposed to budgeted general fund receipts of \$93,187. Total expenses were \$74,506, as opposed to budgeted expenses of \$93,160 which resulted in a net YTD cash flow of a positive \$1,031.

Trustees, squirrel issue at the parsonage was fixed by Brian Humphries. Loose gutter on the south side of the building was repaired by Brad Toone. Bids have come in on sealing and lining the parking lot. The city was quick to replace part of the west sidewalk. The north sidewalk is the church's responsibility.

Membership, the new software (trial) is being reviewed.

Music/Worship, Lynn Haars, reported that the new sound system has been ordered. She also stated how good the congregation sounds singing out during Worship.

Audrey Toone and Jenna Rushing are discussing plans to have a combined GUMDROPS/Family Event sometime in July. They are looking for feedback on plans.

Reverend Seibert reported Men of Grace will hold its first meeting on Sunday, June 25 at the home of George Farley. Eighteen men have signed up so far. Plans are in the works to go to a QC Bandits baseball game on Sunday, July 30. He also reported on the possibility of hiring a Youth Director. Pastor Seibert and Mark Lohman, our Conference Representative, concurred that 28 churches of the 856 member churches in our conference have left the UMC. Pastor Dan shared that First Methodist Church, which disaffiliated on May 6th, sent contact information for 28 of their former members to Grace UMC.

The next Council meeting will be July 24 at 7:00pm. Thank you for your prayers for all committee members and those who serve our Lord and church.
