A small area of concrete on the driveway was replaced. Steps in parsonage garage were rebuilt by Art & Sandy French. An electrician has been contacted concerning wires that connect the rental house and the garage. New copier in the office is working out well. Security cameras have been ordered for the lobby, and Landon Neumann will install them when they arrive. Randy Rutherford will come in and investigate leaks in the foyer the next time it rains. Altar Guild has requested new flooring in Otterbein. They are to get quotes to Trustees. Sharon Campbell reported that she has gotten an estimate from Village Home Store for a new stove. The estimate is \$9494.00 for a 48" stove/oven.
