The Church Council met on Monday, July 24, 2023 at 7:00pm. Jeff Orton opened the meeting with devotion and prayer.

Annual Conference - Mark Lohman gave a report on the Annual Conference, held June 6-8. There was no voting at Annual Conference, but a report was given on the disaffiliation status. Summary reports from Annual Conference can be found on the Grace UMC website.

Staff/Parish - George Farley reported that job descriptions are nearly completed. Discussion on the feasibility of a youth pastor is on-going.

Missions Committee - Karen Doy reported that August 13 has been designated as Missions Sunday. Missions will be doing a Food Pantry Collection August 26-27. Informational flyers are available in the Church lobby, on Grace Facebook, the weekly e-mail, and August's "Connected" newsletter.

Finance Committee - Todd Davison reported that the General Fund balance is \$7,358, down \$40,000 from a year ago. It was approved to use the Anderson Home Fund to cover funds, if needed. Finance Secretary Traci Sigwalt will be sending out the members' statement letters for the first half of the year. Further discussion was held on the possibility of a youth pastor. The committee is also searching for new a treasurer. Rob Rushing will graciously help during this transition.

Trustees - A leak at the parsonage was fixed, resulting in some concrete work on the driveway. One bid for \$22,000 was received for the church parking lot's sealing and striping. Trustees will continue to search for other bids.

Pastor's Report - Pastor Dan reported on the Men's group gathering in June. The Wednesday Evening Bible Study is going well, with 15+ members in attendance. Nominations Committee will be meeting in August. Confirmation classes will begin September 10, and will go through January 14. Confirmation Sunday will be on January 21. Letters were sent to the First United Methodist Church's former members. Reception of new members will be on August 20.

Others in attendance were Lynne Haars, Coral Minge, Mark Mosbarger, Rob Rushing, Traci Sigwalt, and Brad Toone.

#### Confirmation and Youth Group Information 2023-2024






Dear Parents.
