For Staff/Parish George Farley reported that staff evaluations are ongoing & expected to be completed by the end of December 2023. Job descriptions should also be completed by January 2024.

Karen Doy, Missions Chair, reported that there will be Blood Drive on December 28. She also said the Thanksgiving Offering will go the Heifer International while the Christmas offering will go to Chaddock and Baby Fold.

Mark Mosbarger, reported that the Finance Committee, approved the 2024 budget. At the end of September General Fund was up by \$4,000.00. The Finance Committee also discussed Online Giving and Enhanced Giving to make donating to the church easier. Centennial Financial (offices in Davenport & Moline) has been chosen to oversee our financial accounts beginning January 1, 2024. The cost will be \$6,200.00 per year. Coral has been assigned to disperse checks for payment of invoices & reimbursements.

The Trustees are always busy according to Brian Humphries outside wire connecting to the garage was recently replaced at the Anderson house. Concrete for the parsonage drive has been completed. It was decided to postpone purchasing new stoves/ovens. A gas leak alarm has been installed in the kitchen. Ceiling leaks in the lobby were repaired by Randy Rutherford & no leaks have been found since. Security cameras have arrived & will be installed in the lobby by Landon Neumann. George Farley moved to approve new flooring for Otterbein, Albright, and the kitchen. Gayle Barnes seconded, and the motion was approved.

Mark Lohman, our Lay Member to Annual Conference, passed along a prayer from the Bishop for the Middle east. He and others gave a short report on the Charge Conference held at Colona Methodist on October 22.

Response to Membership letters that were sent has been low according to Gayle Barnes. Another Membership letter will be sent next year.

Lynne Haars reported the new sound system is installed but there some concerns about the online sound.
